“Here is my servant, whom I uphold, my chosen one in whom I delight; I will put my Spirit on him, and he will bring justice to the nations. ² He will not shout or cry out, or raise his voice in the streets. ³ A bruised reed he will not break, and a smoldering wick he will not snuff out. 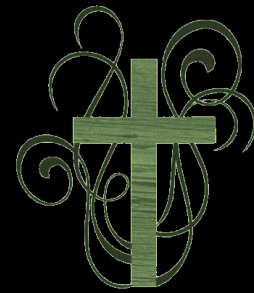

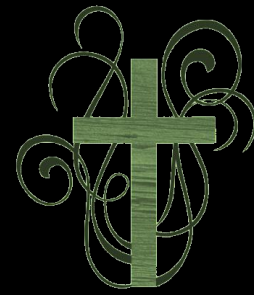

³⁸ how God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Spirit and power, and how he went around doing good and healing all who were under the power of the devil, because God was with him. ³⁹ “We are witnesses of everything he did in the country of the Jews and in Jerusalem. They killed him by hanging him on a cross, ⁴⁰ but God raised him from the dead on the third day and caused him to be seen. ⁴¹ He was not seen by all the people, but by witnesses whom God had already chosen—by us who ate and drank with him after he rose from the dead.



⁴² He commanded us to preach to the people and to testify that he is the one whom God appointed as judge of the living and the dead.



⁴³ All the prophets testify about him that everyone who believes in him receives forgiveness of sins through his name.”

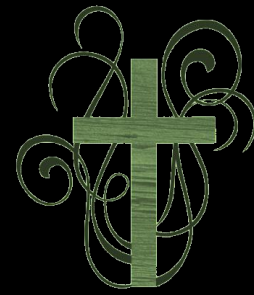
¹⁷ And a voice from heaven said, “This is my Son, whom I love; with him I am well pleased.”

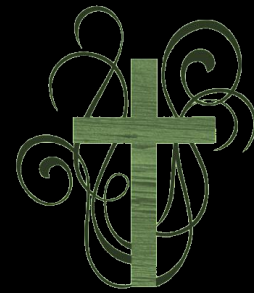

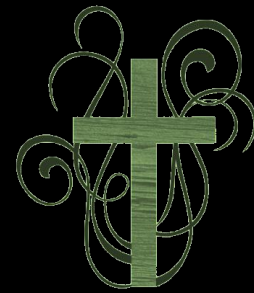
I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Christian church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body and the life everlasting. Amen.



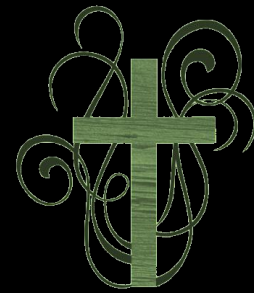

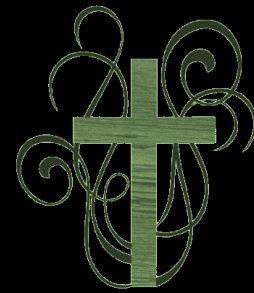

Holy Communion



AM: Sisters and Brothers, it is important to properly prepare and understand Holy Communion.

C: Holy Communion is the body and blood of our Lord, Jesus Christ, received in and under the earthly elements and instituted by Christ himself. The benefit of Holy Communion is pointed out in Christ's words, "Given and shed for you, for the forgiveness of sins." Through these words the forgiveness of sin, life and salvation are given to us in the sacrament; for where there is forgiveness of sin, there is also reconciliation with God and with one another.

Confession and Forgiveness

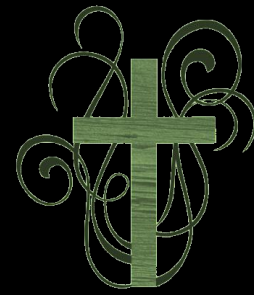

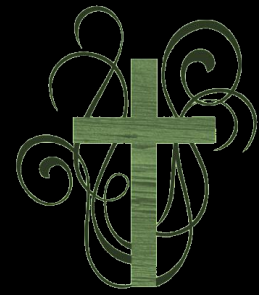
Let us pray.

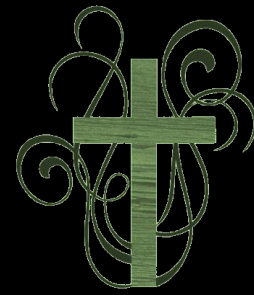

Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name. Thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.

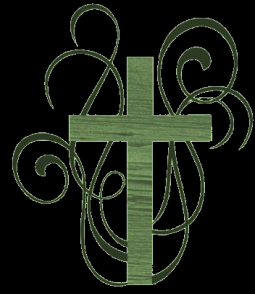

Welcome to the Lord's Supper

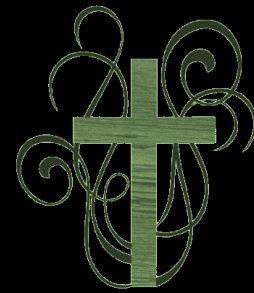
